



Poligof achieves ISCC PLUS certification for its Mira plant

November 11th, 2021 Poligof announce today that Mira plant has successfully passed the audit and received its first ISCC PLUS certification. The plant is now in the position to purchase and sell bio-attributed raw materials and finished products, based on the mass-balance approach supervised by ISCC PLUS.

Following to the certification, Poligof is now launching its new range of bio-attributed backsheets called "PoliBLUE", and it allows Poligof's customers reduce the carbon footprint of their consumer products by replacing fossil feedstocks with bio-based equivalents, without impacting on the production flow and efficiency.

In fact, according to the mass-balance principles, bio-attributed and fossil-based raw materials are blended during the the manufacturing process, to create finished products that can be processed exactly like the standard ones.

Thanks to ISCC PLUS certification schemes, the amount and sustainability features of bio-based content in the value chain is tracked, and the whole process allows to attribute the share of biogenic feedstock to specific batches of finished product, all based on verifiable bookkeeping and verified by ISCC.

The mass balance approach guarantees the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions and fossil feedstock inputs, while the quality and properties of a product remain the same.
